Public Protection: Environmental Health – Ship Sanitation Inspection Fees & Charges 2017/18

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

To seek the approval of the Cabinet Member to increase the Ship Sanitation Inspection charges in line with those recommended by the Association of Port Health Authorities, with effect from 1st April 2017.

The Association of Port Health Authorities have reviewed the current charges for Ship Sanitation Inspections and recommended that they be increased from 1st April 2017. These fees and charges were recommended for all Port Health Authorities authorised to undertake these inspections in the United Kingdom.
