<u>Application for the review of Premises Licence at Eastern European Food 155</u> <u>Commercial Road, Newport NP20 2PJ</u>

The Licensing Sub-Committee were presented an application by Newport City Council Trading Standards for a review of the Premises Licence issued to Maleek (Npt) Limited which was supported by representation from the 'responsible authorities' of Principal Licensing Officer the Police Licensing Officer.

In consideration of the report and evidence presented together with the criminal conviction recorded against the holder of the Premises Licence the Licensing Sub-committee determined to revoke the Premises Licence as the Premises Licence Holder had failed to promote the licensing objective of the prevention of crime and disorder.

The Licensing Sub-Committee were satisfied from the responses given by the Premises Licence Holder that he was fully aware of the evidence which was presented at the hearing and that he further understood that he had a right to appeal their decision to HMCS.
