Private Hire / Hackney Carriage Licences

Decision

The Taxi Panel gave careful consideration to the respective applications and the following decisions were made:

Applicant SSR

 That the applicant be granted the Private Hire Driver's Licence with the condition that attended his GP surgery for the specified period set out by the Panel. That the applicant be granted the Private Hire Driver's Licence with the following condition attached to SSR Private Hire Drivers Licence.

Condition: SSR is required to provide the Licensing Authority a letter from his GP on a monthly basis to confirm his current medical treatment is still compliant with Group 2 Medical standards.

Driver SJA

Councillor Rahman declared an interest and left the room.

 That SJA Private Hire Driver's Licence to be suspended till such time SJA retakes and passes Newport City Council 'Knowledge Test' that includes Child Sexual Exploitation training and the following Condition to be attached to SJA Private Hire Drivers Licence.

Condition: SJA is only permitted to drive a Private Hire Vehicle when that vehicle has CCTV installed and is fully compliant with the Licensing Authority CCTV guidance and encrypted.

Driver FA

1. A formal warning was issued to FA regarding FA conduct and that FA is required to undertake "Pass Plus" driving course alongside the following condition being attached to FA Private Hire and Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence.

Condition: FA is only permitted to drive a Private Hire Vehicle / Hackney Carriage when the vehicle has CCTV installed and the CCTV is fully compliant with the Licensing Authority CCTV guidance.
