Newport Tattoo Convention - Revision of Fees & Charges

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Fees and charges associated with the registration of persons and premises for the purposes of tattooing were agreed on an annual basis. The report set out a proposed reduction of the fees in respect of these activities, only in relation to the Newport Tattoo Convention. The reason for the proposed reduction in fees was to ensure that the event was able to proceed without a prohibitively high fee when considering the short duration of the trading period. It was also consistent with efforts to invigorate the economy within the City Centre and support the profile of the City.

Decision

That the proposed charging regime be introduced from 1 April 2018.
