Emlyn Walk Kingsway Centre, Newport

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

To seek approval from the Cabinet Member for Assets, Equalities & Member Development (Deputy Leader) to vary the lease on Kingsway Centre to allow part disposals and to acquire the freehold interest in 68 Commercial Street Newport to facilitate regeneration proposals for the Emlyn Walk area of the Kingsway Centre.

The Kingsway Centre is owned by the Council and is subject to a long lease to Kingsway Investments Newport (LLP). To improve the Emlyn Walk area of the Kingsway Centre the lessees propose to carry out some demolition and improvement works to create a more open approach to the Kingsway Centre off Commercial Street, to provide an opportunity to create a small development site and to improve the prospects of the future occupation of Sovereign House. This report considers the property transactions that will be required to enable this to happen.

Decision

The Cabinet Member approved the proposed variations to the Kingsway Centre lease and the acquisition of the freehold interest in 68 Commercial Street Newport on terms recommended by Newport Norse and approved by the Head of Law and Regulation.
