Private Hire / Hackney Carriage Licences

Decision

The Taxi Panel gave careful consideration to the respective applications and the following decisions were made:

Applicant TA

1. The Committee carefully considered what had been put before it by way of the report and its contents and what had been said by Mr TA.

The committee had decided that nothing had been put to it which could justify granting a licence to Mr TA, its primary duty being the protection of the public.

The Committee was fully aware, from the report, of Mr TAs history and it had heard nothing to indicate that the applicant could be considered to be a fit and proper person to hold a driver's licence issued by the authority.

The Committee was informed by Mr TA that he was no longer on Facebook. Enquiries made showed such to be untrue.

Driver RR

2. The Committee gave careful consideration to what had been put before it by way of the report, the sworn statements of the witnesses, the CCTV recording, the recording of the complainants call to the Police and what has been said by way of explanation by the respondent himself.

The Committee did not find Mr RRs explanation of events to be at all plausible on the basis of what had been put before it, the committee had decided to revoke Mr RRs licence with immediate effect in the interest of the public safety, for the breach of the conditions which apply and for his in appropriate conduct towards the complainant.
