Primary and Secondary School Meal Prices

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

To consider increasing Primary and Secondary school meal prices across all Newport schools (with the exception of Caerleon Comprehensive School and Newport High School).

The Council has a single contract with Chartwells for the delivery of a school meals service across all sites, with the exception of Caerleon Comprehensive School and Newport High School. Within these contractual arrangements, an annual price review must be carried out to take account of increased food costs and labour charges.

This report considers the appropriateness of increasing school meal prices across the City to accommodate the contract price increase proposed by Chartwells with effect from September 2018.

Decision

To increase the primary school price to £2.15 per meal, the secondary school meal price to £2.40 per meal and the adult meal to £3.30 per meal.

Consultation

Monitoring Officer, Head of Finance, Head of People & Business Change, Chief Education Officer, School Meals Contract Board.

All members were consulted and provided with an opportunity to comment. Any comments received and responses thereafter are set out in the report.
