Private Hire / Hackney Carriage Licences

Decision

The Taxi Panel gave careful consideration to the respective applications and the following decisions were made:

Applicant RS

1. The Committee carefully considered what had been put before it by way of the report and its contents and what had been said by Mr RS.

The Committee had determined to refuse the Private Hire Vehicles Operator Licence but invited Mr S to return with a firm business plan as outlined by the LA.

Driver MU

2. The Committee gave careful consideration to the evidence put before them and decided to issue a warning to Mr MU along with re-taking the Knowledge Test.

Applicant MA

3. The Committee gave careful consideration to the evidence put forward within the application.

The Committee Granted the Private Hire Driver's Licence with the condition that Mr MA provided references from reputable body such as Job Centre or Mosque and CCTV to be installed in his vehicle for security and passengers.

Applicant MH

4. The Committee gave careful consideration to all the evidence put before them and decided to refuse the Private Hire Driver's Licence on the basis that he was not a fit and proper person.
