School Reorganisation Proposal - Expansion of Ysgol Bryn Derw

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Ysgol Bryn Derw is one of two special schools within the City, accommodating pupils aged between 3 years and 19 years who have a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and associated learning difficulties whose needs cannot successfully be met within either mainstream or Learning Resource Base (LRB) provision. The school, with capacity to accommodate 48 pupils, opened in September 2017. The demand for places however continues to be higher than this provision.

There is an annexe building within the grounds of the school which is currently empty. It is proposed that this building is refurbished to provide additional teaching space. This would support the development of additional facilities without any detrimental impact on provision at the school, and indeed at any other school within the City. This proposal will benefit pupils across the whole of the Newport as additional facilities will be provided to support children who have specialist needs in an appropriate and secure environment.

This report recommends moving to a period of formal consultation on this proposal in accordance with the requirements of the statutory School Organisation Code.

Decision

To move to a period of formal consultation on a school reorganisation proposal to expand the Ysgol Bryn Derw site and therefore provide additional pupil places by increasing the capacity of the school from 48 to 68 with effect from September 2019 subject to confirmation of full capital funding from the Gwent Integrated Care Fund (ICF) Capital Investment Plan.
