Waste Strategy Review

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

The Overview and Scrutiny Committee examined proposals for meeting the Council's statutory recycling targets and made a range of recommendations to the Cabinet Member. Officers considered these recommendations, carried out consultation with the public and presented amended proposals

Decision

That the Cabinet Member:

- 1. Noted the responses to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee recommendations.
- 2. Approved the implementation of a ban on disposal of recyclable and compostable waste in domestic rubbish bins.
- Approved the restriction of residual waste capacity for domestic properties in line with the majority of other Welsh Authorities, by introducing a reduced bin size of 120litre for all domestic properties with five or fewer residents.
- 4. Introduced a new engagement and enforcement team to provide assistance and monitor to ensure all residents segregated their waste correctly.
- 5. Approved work to develop a second Household Waste Recycling Centre in Newport.
- 6. Approved the development of recycling focused commercial waste collections.
