Decision

The Taxi Panel gave careful consideration to the respective applications and the following decisions were made:

Driver MC

1. The Panel gave careful consideration to the evidence put before them and decided that MC will have his Licence suspended for one week and pass the Knowledge Test.

Driver JP

1. The Panel gave careful consideration to the evidence put before them and decided JP will have his Licence suspended for two weeks **To be returned** on the condition he passes an Enhanced Group 2 medical **Test**.
Councillor Cleverly declared an interest and left the room.

Driver IM

2. The Panel gave careful consideration to the evidence put before them and decided that IM should have his Licence suspended for one week and pass the Knowledge Test.

Driver CS
