Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

To seek approval from the Cabinet Member for Assets, Equalities & Member Development (Deputy Leader) and Cabinet Member for Education and Skills to declare Talybont Outdoor Education Centre surplus to the Council's requirements and to dispose of the freehold on terms agreed by the Head of Law and Regulation.

Talybont Outdoor Pursuit Centre was due to close in February 2019 and would therefore cease to be operational. This report detailed the reasons for closure and would seek approval to declare the property surplus to the Council's requirements and therefore dispose of the freehold.

Decision

That the subject property be declared surplus and disposed of on terms recommended by Newport Norse and approved by the Head of Law and Regulation.
