1 Question to the Cabinet Member for Culture and Leisure : 2019/24 - The Reopening of Splash Park - Tredegar Park

Councillor J. Watkins asked:

To the relevant Cabinet Member in whose portfolio this sits.

In the interests of openness and transparency could the Cabinet Member please state unequivocally what is the intention of the Authority with regard to the reopening of this facility?

What work has been conducted so far and is the money available to ensure its delivery still available?

What is the sum of the 106 monies available to deliver the project and given there was agreement for the project to go ahead why is there this delay, procrastination, and general obfuscation?

Councillor Harvey responded:

As I announced last week, the project chosen for Tredegar Park section 106 money is the Pedal Power disabled bikes scheme.

Outdoor water-play facilities can only be used for a limited amount of time each year. Whereas bikes available for all abilities provide a benefit to the whole community all year round – the Pedal Power project fits the bill, allowing disabled youngsters and adults the same freedom as others using their bikes in this park.
