Families First Programme

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

This report proposed that the contracts for the strands named below ware extended until 31 March 2020. This extension was outside of the contract terms and was not in compliance with Contract Standing Orders but would allow the Council to implement the flexible funding arrangements for Families First under the new Children and Communities Grant. The Wavehill review of the Programme would be completed and the outputs/outcomes required for Flexible Funding (Children and Communities Grant) should be received which would lead to a procurement and recommissioning exercise for Families First services required within the City by March 31 2020.

To approve the waiving of Contract Standing Orders to extend the Families First contracts with the organisations named below until March 31 2020 to allow for the procurement and recommissioning of new projects which will go live April 1 2020.
