## Capital Funding for accommodation in relation to Children Looked After in Foster Care

#### **Options Considered/Reasons for Decision**

In exceptional circumstances the Local Authority would agree to fund capital development that would be cost effective and reflect the needs of the child where alternative formal care placement would be required; this could be when the Local Authority was not the owner of the building and was unlikely to receive a return on the investment.

#### **Decision**

To ensure appropriate, safe and suitable long-term accommodation was available for children who were looked after.
