School Reorganisation Proposal – Expansion of Ysgol Bryn Derw – Final Determination

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

This school reorganisation proposal was carried out in accordance with the statutory School Organisation Code and included a formal consultation period followed by the publication of a statutory notice for the required period of 28 days.

The consultation passed through the statutory notice stage without objection and therefore a final decision could be taken by the Cabinet Member for Education & Skills for implementation from January 2020.

To approve the school reorganisation proposal "to expand the Ysgol Bryn Derw site and therefore provide additional pupil places by increasing the capacity of the school from 48 to 68 to take effect from January 2020".
