Carbon Management Plan

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

The Council is responsible for direct carbon emissions of c17,000 tonnes CO_{2e} per year, principally related to our buildings, street lighting and fleet. The UK has legally committed for the UK to be carbon neutral by 2050. Welsh Government have set a challenge for the Welsh public sector to be carbon neutral by 2030.

The Carbon Management Plan provides a framework for the council's carbon reduction activities. Its approval will ensure our decarbonisation progresses towards the goal of becoming a carbon neutral organisation by 2030.

Decision

To approve and adopt the Carbon Management Plan attached to this report, as a formal *policy* of Newport City Council.

This will provide a consistent framework to further develop an extensive carbon reduction programme and deliver long-term sustainable environmental and financial benefits.
