#### **Private Hire / Hackney Carriage Licenses**

##### **Decision**

##### **Driver DKM**

The Licensing panel carefully considered the Officer's report and the driver's mitigation and the Licensing Panel felt that this instance had been an oversight on the part of the driver due to mitigating circumstances. The Panel concluded that the driver should receive an official warning and must retake the Knowledge Test but were satisfied the driver was a Fit and Proper Person to retain the Private Hire License with Newport City Council.

##### **Driver FM**

The Licensing panel carefully considered the Officer's report and the driver's mitigation to the Licensing Panel. The Licensing Panel agreed that the driver was a Fit and Proper Person to hold a Private Hire Driver's License with Newport City Council but should receive an official warning. Additionally, the Driver must provide evidence of correct and proper vehicle insurance every month for the first six months.

##### **Driver GS**

The Licensing panel carefully considered the Officer's report and the driver's mitigation to the Licensing Panel. The Licensing Panel agreed that the driver was a Fit and Proper Person to hold a Private Hire Driver's License with Newport City Council but should receive an official warning. Additionally, the Driver must provide evidence of correct and proper vehicle insurance every month for the first six months.
