Private Hire / Hackney Carriage Licenses

Decision

Driver MD

The driver had appealed the points and was no longer required to be heard by the Taxi Licensing Panel.

Driver MQ

The Licensing panel carefully considered the Officer's report and the driver's submission. The Licensing Panel felt that the driver had been sincere in his mitigation but that due to the nature of the offence decided the driver should face a week-long suspension.

Driver NA

The Licensing panel carefully considered the Officer's report and the applicant's mitigation. The Licensing Panel decided that the applicant was a 'Fit and Proper' person and so granted the applicant a Private Hire License with the requirement that the applicant must provide an enhanced DBS check and declaration every 6 months to the Licensing Officers.

Driver SA

The Licensing panel carefully considered the Officer's report and the driver's mitigation to the Licensing Panel. The Licensing Panel concluded that due to the seriousness of the offence the driver should face a month-long suspension. The Licensing Panel also added that the driver must submit evidence that his vehicle has been checked by an appropriate person every 3 months.
