Lease of Indoor Bowls Centre

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Newport Indoor Bowls Club was currently occupied by way of a Management agreement to the Trustees of Newport Indoor Bowling Association. In order that the Association continued with their occupation of the premises it was proposed to offer them a 10-year lease in order that they have more control of the centre which allowed them more income generating opportunities in order that the centre continued to thrive.

Decision

The Cabinet Member granted a 10-year lease of the building to the existing tenant on terms recommended by Newport Norse and agreed by the Head of Law and Regulation.
