Housing Communities Service Plan 2022-24

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

In November 2022, Newport City Council agreed the delivery of the Council's Corporate Plan 2022-27 to deliver an *Ambitious, Fairer, Greener Newport for Everyone*. To support the delivery of the Corporate Plan, each service area developed their service plan of their objectives and key priorities.

The Housing and Communities Service Plan 2022-24 identified three objectives which would support the delivery of the Corporate Plan:

- Improve and increase the provision of housing and housing related support services to meet the needs of Newport's citizens.
- Support the development of Newport's communities and making most effective use of resources available.
- Develop cohesive and inclusive communities across the city through supporting delivery that promoted positive community relations.

Additionally, the service plan included the service area's projects and workforce development which would see continuous improvement of services. To monitor the delivery of services, the Plan also included key performance measures and risks which could prevent the service from achieving its objectives and/or impact delivery.

The Plans would be subject to six monthly reviews by the Council's scrutiny committees and supported the Council's annual Well-being and Self-Assessment Report.

Decision

The Cabinet Members jointly approved the Housing and Communities Service Plan to support the delivery of the Corporate Plan.
