School Reorganisation Proposal – Establishment of a 20-place specialist base for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder at Llanwern High School

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Formal consultation concluded on the school reorganisation proposal "to establish a 20-place specialist base for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder at Llanwern High School with effect from September 2023".

The proposal launched in November 2022, with a six-week period of formal consultation running between 23 November 2022 and 6 January 2023.

A consultation report, which described the consultation process and the feedback received, was prepared (attached as Appendix 1), published on the Newport City Council website, and shared with stakeholders. This decision report referenced those findings, the result of which recommended that the Council move to publish a statutory proposal. Any legal objections lodged during the period of the statutory proposal would be considered in making the final determination.

Decision

The Cabinet Member moved to publish a statutory notice for a period of 28 days in respect of the proposal to establish a 20-place specialist base for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder at Llanwern High School with effect from September 2023.
