Post 16 Home to School Transport Costs

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

In June 2015, a decision was taken by the then Cabinet Member for Education and Young People to suspend a proposed increase to the charges for Post-16 Transport Costs on contracted services and instead set the fee at £370 per academic year in line with the cost of a season ticket on the local bus network.

Since this date, an annual report was brought forward to consider charges for the forthcoming academic year, although no increases have been levied. As a result, the level of charges remained unchanged since June 2015, and consequently there was no reduction in the subsidy paid by the Council for this service.

Decision

The Cabinet Member for Education and Early Years confirmed that the charges for the 2023/24 academic year should be maintained in line with those applied for the 2022/23 academic year.
