Children and Communities Grant (CCG) - Newport Local Delivery Plan 2024/25

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Welsh Government provided the Childrens and Communities Grant each year to Local Authorities in Wales. Local Authorities had a responsibility to decide how this grant was allocated locally based on need, within the confines of the terms and conditions attached to the grant. There were specific work streams expected to be supported via local delivery of the grant, with a combination of flexible and ring-fenced conditions. In 2024/25 the CCG grant allocation was to be reduced by Welsh Government for the first time.

This report set outs the proposed delivery of a range of support to residents across the city in order to frame the delivery plan required by Welsh Government.

The attached draft Delivery Plan was submitted to Welsh Government in line with submission timeframes. Initial feedback was received from Welsh Government with some recommendations. The final version would be amended in line with the contents of this report and approval from Cabinet to be submitted on 1 March 2024.

This Delivery Plan will enable the services to continue supporting large numbers of individuals in Newport and their families with issues and concerns that matter to them.
