Eveswell Community Centre- proposal for Community Asset Transfer to the Toc H Charity

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

The Council was approached by the national charity Toc H who submitted an expression of interest for the Community Asset Transfer of the Eveswell Community Centre site, including the building currently leased by the council to the Good Companions Club. This proposal had the potential to bring a currently under-utilised site 'back-to-life' as the focus for a range of community activities.

The report supported the redevelopment of the site Toc H intention to submit an application for capital funding through the Community Ownership Fund in April. The funding application by Toc H would be significantly strengthened if they received confirmation of Newport City Council's agreement to their proposal (subject to due diligence) and this report sought that support in principle.

The proposal to transfer the asset to a community-based organisation in a sustainable way by way of a 25-year lease (subject to appropriate funding and due diligence) was supported by the Council's Corporate Plan and draft Strategic Asset Management Plan.

Decision

The Cabinet Member for Infrastructure and Assets supported the CAT transfer approach by Toc H, agreeing a 25-year lease subject to due diligence checks and analysis of the final business plan.
