### School Reorganisation Proposal – Establishment of a new Primary School at Great Milton Park

#### Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Formal consultation had concluded on the school reorganisation proposal being progressed by the Council "to establish a new primary school for pupils aged between 3 years and 11 years on the Great Milton Park housing development with effect from September 2026". The proposal launched in November 2024, with formal consultation running between 11 November 2024 and 22 December 2024.

A consultation report, which described in detail the consultation process and the feedback received, was prepared and accompanied this report. It was also published on the Newport City Council website and shared with stakeholders. This decision report referenced the findings, the result of which recommended that the Council moved to publish a statutory proposal. Any legal objections lodged during the statutory proposal period would be considered when making the final determination.

#### Decision

The Deputy Leader/Cabinet Member for Education and Early Years took a Decision to move to publish a statutory notice for a period of 28 days in respect of the proposal to establish a new primary school at Great Milton Park with effect from September 2026.

All members were consulted and provided with an opportunity to comment. Any comments received and response thereafter are set out in the report.
