MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT DECLARATION OF PERSONAL INTEREST

Paragraph 11 of the Authority's Code of Conduct requires that Councillors must provide written notification to the Monitoring Officer:-

- (a) when a personal interest has been disclosed orally at a meeting, for the first time or
- (b) when a personal interest has been disclosed when making oral representations to any Member or officer

If you consider that the information relating to your personal interest is "sensitive information" (i.e. information whose availability for inspection by the public creates, or is likely to create, a serious risk that you or a person with whom you live may be subjected to violence or intimidation) then you do not need to include this information in Section C, if the Monitoring Officer agrees.
